OVERALL OBJECTIVE (As stated in the Matrix, max. 200 words)

1. Education to educators, students should be promoted. It should start from the primary education. Education to Architects, professionals, designers are as important. European Council recommendations from 18 countries in Region 2 provide a good model.
2. International architectural competitions shall include Architecture for All in the conditions of the brief and in the assessment as well. One of the jurors shall be from the UIA Work Programme on Architecture for All from that region.
3. Awards for accessible built environment in each region.
4. Barrier free access -accessibility - design for all - technical to social. However, it should not only for "design" but should be more inclusive. It should be in a global perspective.
5. Introduce a web page on Architecture for All in the UIA web page to connect all the regions. Information on the web should be universal accessible.

6. Design for all shall include environment and ecological issues.

4. Promote of UN Convention of Rights of Persons with Disabilities - legislations and building regulations to be upgraded.

6. Promote international workshops to regional students.
7. Outreach to Region V (Africa).
8. Collaborate with Japanese Schools of Architecture
